1. **Eligibility.** The rebate project must be completed for a CPS Energy account holder within in the CPS Energy service area. Rebate will not exceed the cost of the project. This rebate does not qualify for new homes. Please see our rebates available for New Home Construction.
2. **Project Timeline.** Applications and supporting documents must be filed within 30 days of the completion of the work. The project must be completed between September 1, 2016 and May 31, 2017.
3. **Permitting.** To qualify for the rebate, all HVAC equipment must be installed by an HVAC contractor licensed in the State of Texas. Installers shall secure and pay for all permits, governmental fees, and licenses necessary for proper completion of the Project. Upon request, the installer shall provide CPS Energy with a copy of the electrical permit or the green tag inspection.

5. **Documentation.** Applications must be signed by account holder. **Missing documentation will delay processing.** Contractor's invoice/purchase receipt must be provided and show model number and serial number of all equipment installed.
 - For Central Air, this includes condenser, coil, and furnace.
 - Central Air and Heat Pump rebates requires an Air Conditioning, Heating & Refrigeration Institute (AHRI) certificate.
 - For insulation rebates, invoice must include square footage of work area.
6. **Inspection and Verification.** Applications are subject to verification. If the verification cannot be completed, the rebate will not be paid. All Applications are subject to an inspection by CPS Energy or its designated agent. CPS Energy reserves the right to reduce or reject the rebate amount requested if the product installed was not done in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
7. **Payment.** Once completed paperwork is submitted, rebate payments are usually made within 8-10 weeks. All rebate checks are payable to the account holder named on the utility bill (unless payment release authorization request has been made). Incomplete applications will either delay payments or result in denial of application approval. CPS Energy reserves the right to refuse payment and participation if the account holder or contractor violates program terms and conditions.
